#### A. Winter Drawdown Update

- The sluice gate will be opened on December 1<sup>st</sup> to begin the winter lake drawdown.
- Lake Lemon is currently at normal pool, 1 foot below normal lake level at beginning of 08' drawdown.

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#### B. Approval of 2010 Surplus Parcel Sublease Agreement

There have been no changes to the 2009 Sublease agreement. Prices and Agreement remain the same for 2010.

### E. Dredging Disposal Site Update

 Both East End Disposal Sites have been presented to the City of Bloomington Utilities Department for review and ultimate approval.

 Madden proposed that the LLCD sell the unused Dynasty boat trailer currently located at Riddle Point Park for the appraised value of \$265.00.

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
