Why Lemon Aid?

If you know Lake Lemon, you are well aware of all it has to offer – great fishing, serene vistas, fun water recreation, to name just a few.

The fact is, Lake Lemon is shrinking due to sedimentation flowing into it. The lake is already at least 250 acres smaller than when it was built. Although the Lake Lemon Conservancy District (LLCD) has made strides in managing water quality; controlling nuisance vegetation; and running a shoreline stabilization and dredging program, they are not enough to stop the flow of sediment.

Addressing the larger sedimentation issue requires far more resources and money than LLCD's regular budget can bear. Thus, we created The Lake Lemon Enhancement Fund and Lemon-Aid Days events which are integral to our efforts to raising money to sustain the lake.
