The September 21, 2011 meeting of the Lake Lemon Conservancy District was held at the Benton Township Senior Citizen Building and was called to order by Chairman John Schell at 6:05 p.m.

BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT: John Schell, Marty Mann, Tina Thrasher, Pam Dugan, Bruce Cassal, Dennis Friesel, , and Tim Specht. ALSO PRESENT: Bob Madden, Manager; Adam Casey, Board Recorder; and LLCD Freeholders (see attached sign-in sheet) ABSENT: Rachel Atz, CBU Representative.

I. OPENING COMMENTS (Schell)

• Schell thanked all freeholders for attending the meeting.

II. APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES (Schell)

- Approval of August 13, 2011 Board Meeting Minutes.
- Approval of September 7, 2011 Public 2012 Budget Hearing Meeting Minutes

THRASHER MOTIONED TO APPROVE THE AUGUST 13, 2011 BOARD MEETING MINUTES AS WRITTEN. SPECHT SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL "AYES". MOTION CARRIED.

THRASHER MOTIONED TO APPROVE THE SEPTEMBER, 7, 2011 PUBLIC HEARING FOR 2012 PROPOSED BUDGET MEETING MINUTES. SPECHT SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL "AYES". MOTION CARRIED.

III. TREASURER'S REPORT (Friesel)

- Friesel presented the budget as of August (see attached).
- LLCD August income: \$20,027.00
- LLCD August expenses: \$49,584.00

FRIESEL MOTIONED TO APPROVE ALLOWANCE OF VOUCHERS FOR THE MONTH OF AUGUST, 2011. CASSAL SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL "AYES." MOTION CARRIED.

IV. MANAGER'S REPORT (Madden)

A. 2011-2012 Winter Drawdown Discussion

 The LLCD Board of Directors unanimously decided to open the sluice gate on Monday, November, 21st 2011, and keeping the sluice gate open until a 6 ft drawdown has been achieved.

B. 2012 Board Meeting Discussion

- The board of directors decided to hold only one board meeting in the month of September, 2012; combining the historically independent proposed budget hearing meeting and the regularly scheduled September meeting.
- The June 2012 Board of Directors meeting will be held at Riddle Point Park, resulting in three of the 2012 meetings (June, July and August) being held at the Riddle Point Park Shelter House.

C. Follow Up: Insurance Deductibles

- Manager Madden, per board request, has been in contact with and received a report stating how much money could be saved on an annual basis by increasing certain insurance deductibles (See attached)
- The Board of Directors believed the savings were substantial enough to be worth pursuing.

CASSAL MOTIONED TO INCREASE THE DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS COVERAGE DEDUCTIBLE TO \$5,000.00 AND THE EQUIPMENT DEDUCTIBLE TO \$1,000.00, EFFECTIVE JANUARY, 1ST 2011, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE LLCD INSURANCE AGENT. SPECHT SECONDED. ALL "AYES". MOTION CARRIED.

D. Submittal of Disclosure Forms

- Schell has submitted his disclosure forms and the LLCD Attorney has reviewed and provided recommendations for their completion.
- Schell anticipates submitting the forms to the board at the October board meeting.

E. Trees and Shrubs along Riddle Point Park Shoreline/Long Causeway; No Parking Signs along long causeway.

- The trees growing in the rip-rap around Riddle Point Park have been cut down. Currently we are in the process of treating the remaining green briar.
- A letter was received from the Monroe County Highway Department stating that no trees along the causeway would be removed any time soon due to budgetary constraints.
- The board decided not to pursue having no parking signs installed along the long causeway.

F. Follow Up: Utilities Discussion

- Madden presented a few options for reducing monthly utility costs (cable, phone, internet & electrical usage) at the LLCD Office and Park Grounds (See Attached).
- The board requested a second quote for the electrical work and agreed to have all phone, cable and internet service with Comcast

G. CATS: Update

- The Monroe County Commissioners approved the CATS request and sent a letter to CATS general manager Michael White.
- Mr. White, in an email, stated that the CATS budget has been frozen and no decision to video tape LLCD board meetings will be made at this time.

H. Dam/Spillway Repairs: Update

- Attached is a copy of the dam repair recommendations from CDS Construction. Management recommends completing the suggested repairs to the sluice gate but holding off on the dam inspection for two more years.
- Madden is working on getting quotes for the concrete work that needs to be completed in the stilling basin.

V. Bloomington Boys and Girls Club: 2011 Camp Rock Report: Audrey Hall, Camp Director

• Audrey was unable to attend the meeting due to a late change in her schedule.

VI. Recognition: Former Director Dave Hobson

- Madden introduced former director Dave Hobson and presented him with a certificate of appreciation.
- A one hundred dollar donation was given to the Boys and Girls club in the name of Dave Hobson.

VII. PUBLIC COMMENT

• Freeholder Gail Tala met with the City of Bloomington mayor to discuss any potential development that was to take place around Lake Lemon. Mayor Kruzan sent a reply letter to Gail stating there is no future planned development around Lake Lemon utilizing City of Bloomington property. (See Attached)

VIII. NEW BUSINESS / CORRESPONDENCE FOR FUTURE AGENDA

• On Saturday, September 24th, the 3rd annual Phi Kappa Psi triathlon will be taking place at Riddle Point Park as well as the BYC's annual mayor's sailing regatta.

- Several freeholders mentioned a recent rapid growth of aquatic vegetation around their docks. Casey stated that he would check it out.
- The next LLCD Board of Directors meeting will be held on Wednesday, October 19th, 2011.

#### Good afternoon Bob,

Thank you for contacting me regarding issues along the causeway on Southshore Drive. I will respond to the issues you raise below;

<u>Parking along the causeway</u> - in order to have an enforceable parking restriction along this road segment, it will take the action of two boards. The first part of the process is a public hearing before the Monroe County Traffic Commission, which consist of the Sheriff, the Highway Superintendent, myself and four citizen appointments. The Traffic Commission will make a recommendation for the restriction via a formal ordinance adoption process. In the review of this request, we will review road and shoulder widths, average daily traffic and crash history in the particular area. The decision will be based on these factors. If the Traffic Commission recommends approval and the Board of Commissioners approve the ordinance, it is then advertised in the newspaper one time prior to it becoming enforceable.

If you would like to make this request, please contact Laura Lane, Traffic Commission Secretary, at 349-2555. She and John Chambers, Chairman, are copied on this as well.

<u>Tree timing and cutting</u> - as with all budgets of local government units across the Country, our problem is no different. We have reduced efforts of mowing and other preventive maintenance measures because we simply do not have the money. I will pass this along to John Chambers, Highway Superintendent, to see if something could be done in the future, when we are in the area but please do not expect anything soon.

Electrical service for Riddle Point Park and LLCD Office is provided by South Central Indiana Rural Electric Membership Corporation (SCI REMC).

Currently, the park has four electrical meter boxes. One each for the office; gatehouse; maintenance shed and shelter house/restrooms.

Each meter box has a minimum monthly service charge of \$33.04 each. (This does not include power (KWH) charges).

In an effort to cut costs, the District has two options available to consider.

#### Option I

We could put three of the four meter boxes on vacation for 3 months during the winter. Installation of a "collar" to the meter box would cost \$50.00 per box.

Cost: 3 meter boxes @ \$50.00 each = \$150.00

Savings: 3 meter boxes x \$33.04 monthly service charge x 3 months = \$297.36

Year one savings = \$297.36 - \$150.00 = \$147.36

Year two and beyond savings would be \$297.36/year

#### Option II

We could eliminate two of the four meter boxes by combining the gate house, maintenance shed and office into one box. The meter box for the shelter house/restrooms would remain separate due to distance, but could still be put on vacation.

The attached letter from Vernon Sweeney, Engineering Technician, SCI REMC explains option II very well.

In essence, SCI REMC would set a new meter pole (at no charge) that would service the gate house, office and maintenance shed. We were also successful in having SCI REMC donate their existing Triplex cable which can be used for the office and maintenance shed.

The District would have to purchase a new meter base, two riser pipes, a disconnect for the new meter pole and overhead triplex cable to connect the gate house. Additionally, the District would need to hire an electrician to complete the work. (See attached quote)

Cost: \$2,300.00 (materials and electrician labor) + \$50.00 collar for Shelter house/Bathroom meter box = \$2,350.00

Savings: \$792.96 (2 meter boxes x \$33.04 monthly service charge per box x 12 months) + \$99.12 (1 meter box x \$33.04 monthly service charge x 3 months on vacation) = \$892.08 yearly savings

In approximately 2 1/2 years the savings will pay for the one-time costs.

#### Robert:

Per our discussion on August 1st, There are essentially 2 options regarding consolidation of services (meters) at the Riddle Point Park location. The first and least costly for the conservancy district would be to have collars installed on the meter bases at the gatehouse, maintenance building, and the shelterhouse locations. There would be a one time fee of \$50 per meter and would allow those services to be selectively turned off and on from our main office at times designated by you or your staff. If this were done for the winter period of December, January and February, savings of the monthly minimum service charge of approximately \$34 would result in a savings of \$308 during that time period. However, a second option would be the complete elimination of the meters on the gatehouse and maintenance building and the relocation of the meter for the office to a more centrally located meter pole which could serve all three of those sites. SCIREMC would set a meter pole at no charge for this purpose. There would however be costs for the conservancy district in the purchase of a new meter base, 2 riser pipes, and disconnect for the new meter pole. Also, overhead triplex cable (approximately 337 ft) would need to be purchased and strung from the meter pole to the three locations mentioned above. This work would need to be done by an electrician engaged by the conservancy district. The work done under the 2nd option would entail more expense up front, but would save \$816 annually. The meter located near the shelter house restrooms would still require a collar because of its distance from the other metered sites and would save an additional \$102 per year (if shut down for 3 months) by using this option. The single meter pole might be a good choice if you can get an attractive price from an electrician to do this work. SCIREMC does not currently perform any work beyond the meter base and leaves this type of work to private contractors. The single meter pole would need to be sited near the existing transformer pole just west of the gatehouse and would entail cutting and/or trimming some trees there (this could be done by SCIREMC). That transformer pole will be replaced by a new pole at no charge in addition to the setting of a meter pole at that location. Please advise as to your preference of option and give me a call if you have any questions regarding this matter.
