## Lake Lemon Conservancy District Dredging Study Group 2013

## Introduction

The Lake Lemon Conservancy District Board of Directors at the February 6, 2013

Annual Board Meeting, by consensus, authorized a re-structured Dredging Study Group.

The Study Group will now have representation from all seven (7) sub-areas of the

District. The purpose of the Study Group is to study our current Sediment Removal

Program's efficiency and effectiveness, and to make future recommendations to the entire

LLCD Board of Directors. The Dredging Study Group will consist of three District

Directors, LLCD staff, and up to four additional Freeholders. Currently the study group

includes: Tim Specht, Sub-Area II Director; Pam Dugan, Sub-Area VI Director; Tina

Thrasher, Sub-Area VII Director; Bob Madden, District Manager; James Van Tassel,

Lake Biologist; and Levi Warthan, Dredger. The additional four Freeholders will be

selected by their respective District Director. A preliminary brainstorming session took

place on February 23, 2013 at the LLCD Office with the three directors and LLCD staff.

This organizational session was held in preparation for the first official Dredging Study

Group Meeting on April 13, 2013.
