Things to Consider & Suggested Items to Bring

Considering we are dead center for totality in this eclipse, please expect that traffic will be heavy, and that lines for local services such as restaurants, gas stations, grocery, and retail stores will likely be much longer than usual. Lake Lemon's Riddle Point Park is 11 miles from Bloomington on a two-lane road, so limit your trips and be patient!

Everyone should consider the following:

- **Never look at the sun without special eye protection:** Each wristband will come with one pair of viewing glasses. We will have extras for sale on site.
- It might not be the best line of thinking to say, "We can just pick up what we need when we get there." We have a feeling that there will be limited services &/or long lines because of high demand. Due to increased visitors to the area, there may be shortages of some items:
 - o Arrive with a full tank of gas.
 - o ATMs may be temporarily of cash.
 - o Bring cash! Due to overloaded internet, credit card usage could be problematic.
- Bring water We will have water available, but it's a great idea to bring your own.
- Be self-sufficient with ample food, snacks, & other supplies for the entire time. We will have food trucks on site, but you should be prepared with your own food, too.
- Bring a fully stocked first aid kit.
- Bring all necessary medications for you and your pets.
- Sun protection: Sunscreen, sunglasses, hat/visor
- · Comfortable walking shoes.
- Printed maps of the area in case your cell service is interrupted.
- Ensure your vehicle/RV has been serviced and you are fueled up and ready to go (gas, propane, etc.)
- We have plenty of trash bins and trash dumpsters on site, so please keep your site clean.
- While we have multiple charcoal grills on property, we recommend you bring self-contained grills or propane camp stoves for cooking &/or night fires.
- Lawn chairs, tables, & personal shade (small umbrellas & big hats permitted.)
- There is no ice available on the property consider a well-insulated ice chest.
