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Riddle Point Park Rules:

- Park Hours: 8am to 8pm
Memorial Day – Labor Day
- Park gates lock at 8pm
- No overnight camping
- No ground fires permitted
- No glass on beach
- No littering
- No off-road vehicles

Park & Amenities

Park admission is charged from Memorial Day to Labor Day. Visit our website for current daily and annual pass rates.

- Sand beach, roped off swim area (swim at own risk, no lifeguards)
- Playground
- Park grills

- Flush-equipped bathrooms (port-o-lets at the ramp)

- Short tree identification hiking trail

Fishing & Boating

Riddle Point is optimal for shoreline fishing, as it is surrounded by water on three sides and has ample shoreline.

- Bluegill
- Channel Catfish
- Common Carp
- Crappie
- Flat Head Catfish
- Largemouth bass
- Yellow bass

Please do not move the rip rap rocks, these are vital for shoreline stabilization.

Public boat ramp with daily and annual launch permits are available for purchase.
